

## Announcement of Faculty Position in Counseling

### Reformed Theological Seminary, Orlando

#### Job Description

Reformed Theological Seminary in Orlando invites applications and nominations for a full-time faculty appointment at the level of Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor of Counseling, available from summer 2023. Area of specialization is open. The Search Committee will begin its work immediately to fill this position. Primary responsibilities will include teaching courses in the CACREP-accredited Master of Arts in Counseling (MAC) degree program.

#### Requirements

The qualified candidate will:

- have a PhD in Counselor Education (or be ABD) *or* have a related doctoral degree and have been employed as a full-time faculty member in a counselor education program for a minimum of one full academic year before July 1, 2013
- possess clinical supervisory experience
- possess mental health counseling licensure or eligibility for licensure in Florida
- demonstrate a concern for ministry in the church as well as professional mental health counseling
- desire a collaborative and unified pedagogical relationship with fellow RTS faculty
- be committed to Reformed theology as expressed in the Westminster Standards
- be competent in speaking theologically about and commending Christian counseling

Some combination of other qualifications may mark out exceptional candidates, such as:

- ability in or potential for scholarship
- teaching experience in higher education (especially in a CACREP-accredited program)
- other vocational ministry experience

We especially encourage female and ethnic minority candidates to apply.
